Awkwardness as Activism: Embracing vulnerability in Love, Activism and Witness

Elsie is a feminist, youth worker, researcher, Quaker and quiet activist. She works in the fields of gender and sexuality and has spent the last four years researching sexual consent and negotiation with young people – and along the way has become pretty good at awkward conversations. In this session Elsie takes some of her learning from this work to think through the radical and transformative potential of embracing and moving through awkwardness in everyday conversations about spiritual, political and personal issues. She hopes to encourage you to jump into awkward situations rather than avoid them, as a way of living out everyday activism.
