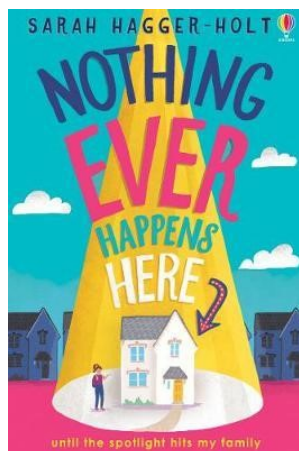


Books of the Month February 2020 for Children & Young Adults

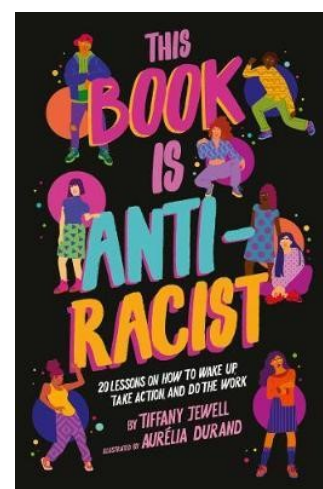


NOTHING EVER HAPPENS HERE Sarah Hagger-Holt £6.99

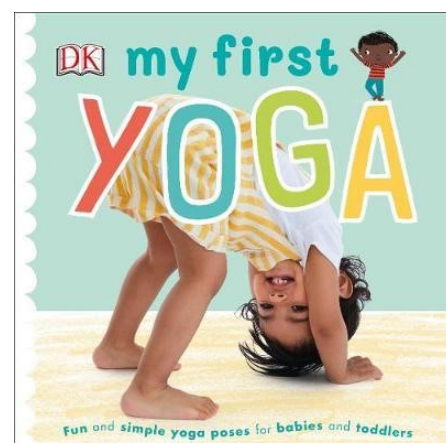


GRETA'S STORY Valentina Camerini £6.99

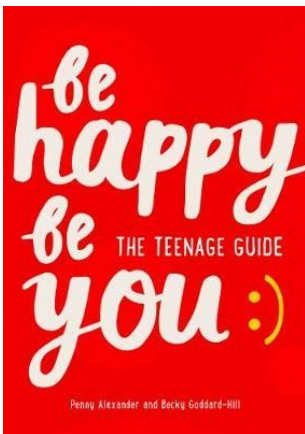
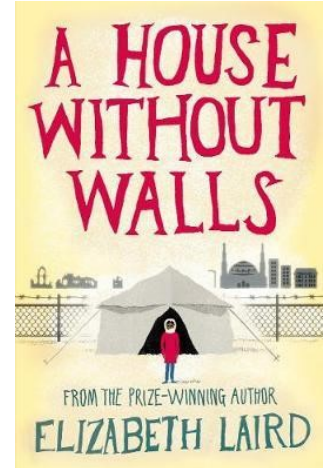
Kathy MacMillan £18.99
